NOTICE OF TEST OF WATER SHUT-OFF

Notice must be given to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector at least five days before the test. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the water shut-off before drilling into the productive sand whenever possible.

If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

In running 7" O.D. Casing stuck at 3254' was perforated at 2960' and cemented with 100 sacks Incor cement - then run 5 1/2" O.D. to 3420' and cemented back to 2000' with Incor Cement.
