for approval of a non-standard gas proration
unit embracing the S/2 SE/4 Sec. 36-24S-36E,
Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Gentlemen:

Comes now Cities Service Oil Company and respectfully requests the Oil Conservation Commission to approve a non-standard gas proration unit of 80 acres, embracing the S/2 SE/4 Sec. 36-24S-36E, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

In support of this application we wish to state the following:

1. The Cities Service Oil Company is the owner of the State "W" lease comprising the S/2 SE/4 Sec. 36-24S-36E, Lea County, New Mexico.
2. State "W" #1, located 660' N, 660' W, SE corner Sec. 36-24S-36E, was formerly a Langlie-Mattix oil well producing through perforations from 3370 to 3524 TD.
3. During the past month the State "W" #1 was plugged back to 3335, and the Yates, and upper Seven Rivers formations were perforated from 2800-2820, 2830-2850, 2870-2885, 2890-2900, 2920-2930, 2940-2970, 3005-3030, 3050-3100. Its initial potential May 20, 1955 was 1312 MCF gas, 24 hours, 20/64" choke, with 6.44 barrels oil per MMCF gas.
4. It is requested that a non-standard gas proration unit of 80 acres be assigned this well, since it meets all requirements of Order R-520 for classification as a Jalmat Pool gas well.
5. A plat is attached showing the well location and offset ownership.
6. All operators in Section 36, and those owning interests within 1500' of the State "W" #1 have been notified by registered mail of this application.

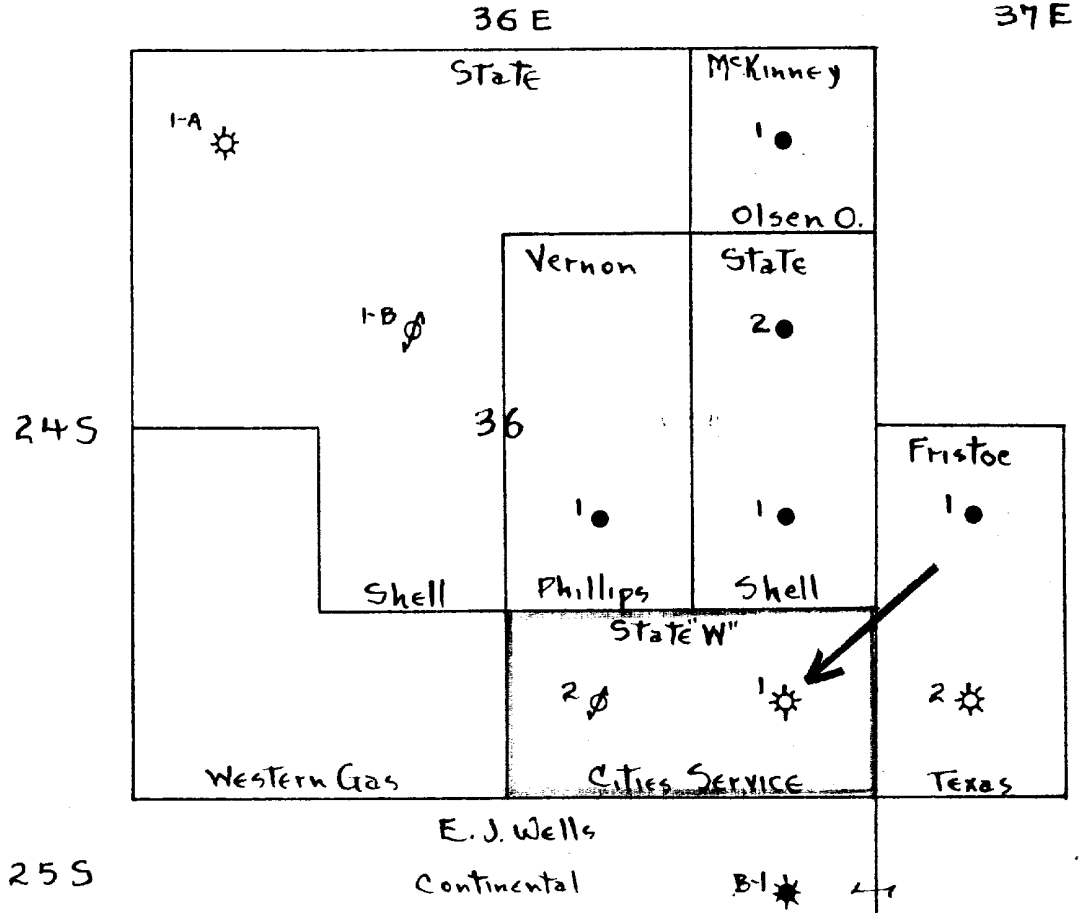
