Gentlemen:

Enclosed is an application from Shell Oil Company to dual complete our State No. 2A in the Jalmat Gas and Langlie Mattix Oil Pools. Also enclosed is a diagrammatic sketch of the dual completion installation and an ownership map of the area. The well is located in Unit H, Section 36, T-24-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

As illustrated by the enclosed sketch, the Langlie Mattix oil will be produced through tubing, and the Jalmat gas will be produced through the casing tubing annulus. A deliverability in excess of 1500 MCF per day and a minimum shut-in pressure of 600 psi is expected for the gas zone in the Shell State No. 2A.

All operators listed in Item 5 of the application will be notified by copies of this letter. Please advise if any further information is desired concerning this request.
