Ran 12,949' of 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (20#, N-80, Republic, SR-R2, with LT&C, and 17#, N-80, SR-R3, National, with LT&C), casing and cemented @ 12,965' with 410 sacks Lonestar Incoer plus 40% Diacel "D" plus 200 sacks Trinity inferno slt-set plus 4% gel. Bumped plug with 750 psi @ 9:25 p.m. (MST), June 12, 1960. After WOC 48 hours, tested casing with 3000 psi for 30 minutes - no pressure drop. Cement top @ 7505' by Temperature Survey.

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
