Drilled well to 3402'. Ran 108 joints, 3390' of 5-1/2" OD casing set at 3400'. Cemented with 1400 sacks 8% gel regular cement mixed with 87 sacks strata Crete followed by 100 sacks neat cement. Pumped plug to 3373'. Cement circulated to surface. Tested casing before and after drilling plug. No pressure loss.
