the Secretary of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for  
administrative approval for an exception to Order No. R-553 as  
pertaining to the flaring of gas in the Langlie Mattix Pool, Lea  
County, New Mexico; and in support thereof wishes to make the  
following statements:

1. That the petitioner is the operator of a 320 acre  
lease known as its Mexico "P" Lease, located in the E/2 of Section 2  
T-24-S , R-37-E in the Langlie Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

2. That the petitioner is the operator of the well  
listed below.

3. That it is uneconomical, at this time, to arrange for a  
casinghead gas connection due to the negligible amount of gas being  
produced.

4. That a plat showing offset ownership, and well and  
tank battery location has been prepared and is true and correct to  
the best of our knowledge.

5. That all provisions of paragraph 10, Order No. R-520  
have been complied with as pertaining to the filing of form C-110  
on the well listed above

WHEREFORE, the petitioner requests that the Secretary of  
the Commission grant an exception to Order R-553, whereby the  
petitioner may flare gas from the above well.
