Gentlemen:

Attached is a copy of Page 32 of the April, 1974, Southeast Gas Proration Schedule listing Myers Langlie-Mattix Unit Well No. 181 as being in the Jalmat Gas Pool. This is in error since Skelly's Myers Langlie-Mattix unit Well No. 181 is a plugged and abandoned zone in Amoco's Myers "B" Federal RA/A Well No. 2, which we understand is producing from the Jalmat Gas Pool and operated by Amoco.

The Myers Langlie-Mattix Unit became effective February 1, 1974, at which time a Form C-104 was filed in order to change ownership as to the Langlie-Mattix formation (unitized zone) in Amoco's Myers "B" Federal RA/A Well No. 2. It appears that the Commission records as to operator have been changed for the Jalmat Gas Pool in this well from Amoco to Skelly in error.

Please advise if any action is required by this office to correct the gas proration schedule and the Commission's records for this well.
