Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the S/2 of Section 4, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This acreage was to have been assigned to your C Meyers "B" Well No. 2, located 330' from the South and West lines of Section 4.

Order R-520, Rule 5 (a) paragraph 3, clearly limits, as to the well location, the number of acres that can be assigned a non-standard gas proration unit. This office is unable to grant approval of a non-standard gas proration unit for the above mentioned well of over 160 acres because of the said well's location to its boundaries.
