DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was cleaned out to original total depth, 3605', and deepened in sandy lime to 3620'. On 8-11-43 it was shot with 105 quarts of nitro-glycerine (El-357) from 3570' to 3616', using a 4' sand cushion on bottom and 2-1/2 yard gravel tamp. Before cleaning out, deepening and shooting, the well was flowing approximately 2 bbls. oil/day. After the work was completed, 9-13-43, it flowed 22 barrels oil in 48 hours through 2" tubing and is now averaging approximately 8 barrels per day.
