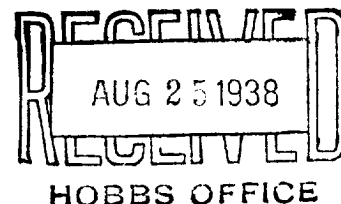

## SECTION SUBMITTAL NOTICE

This notice is to inform you that the Department of Defense (DoD) is currently conducting a review of the information submitted to it by the Department of Energy (DoE) regarding the proposed construction of a new nuclear power plant. The review is being conducted to ensure that the information submitted is accurate and complete, and that it meets the requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954.

### Information to be Submitted

The information to be submitted to the DoD should include the following:

- 1. A detailed description of the proposed construction project, including the location, size, and design of the plant.
- 2. A description of the proposed construction schedule, including the start and end dates of the project.
- 3. A description of the proposed construction budget, including the estimated costs of the project.
- 4. A description of the proposed construction personnel, including the names and qualifications of the key personnel involved in the project.
- 5. A description of the proposed construction materials, including the types and quantities of materials to be used.
- 6. A description of the proposed construction equipment, including the types and quantities of equipment to be used.
- 7. A description of the proposed construction safety measures, including the measures to be taken to ensure the safety of the construction workers and the public.
- 8. A description of the proposed construction environmental measures, including the measures to be taken to minimize the impact of the construction on the environment.

### Submission Requirements

The information submitted to the DoD should be submitted in the following format:

- 1. The information should be submitted in a written format, including a written report and supporting documents.
- 2. The information should be submitted in a clear and concise format, using simple and direct language.
- 3. The information should be submitted in a complete format, including all relevant information and documents.
- 4. The information should be submitted in a timely format, meeting the deadlines set by the DoD.
- 5. The information should be submitted in a secure format, ensuring that the information is protected from unauthorized access.
