## MEMORANDUM FOR THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

Re: Application of the New York State Board of Education for a writ of habeas corpus to compel the Board to comply with the provisions of Chapter 108 of the Laws of 1906, relating to the reorganization of the Board of Education.
