Attached are packer setting affidavit, packer leakage test, and diagrammatic sketch of equipment installation for the subject well.

Approval to dually complete the well in the Jalmat (Gas) Pool (Yates-Seven Rivers formations) and Langlie-Mattix Pool (Penrose formation) was granted by Order No. DC-932, dated May 4, 1960. The Jalmat (Gas) reservoir was not pro-ductive of gas, oil or water; therefore, the well was singly completed in the Langlie-Mattix Pool. A Baker Model "D" permanent-type packer had been set between the zones prior to determining that the Jalmat (Gas) reservoir was not productive; therefore, due to the expense involved, it was decided to not squeeze off these perforations. A single string of tubing with seal nipples latched into the Baker packer, effectively separates the productive Langlie-Mattix pay from the nonproductive Jalmat (Gas) section above. Should remedial work be necessary on the Langlie-Mattix zone in the future the Jalmat section will be squeezed off at that time.
