

(3) Produce the Langlie Mattix pool oil through the tubing and the Langmat Pool gas through the tubing-casing annulus.

(d) That the granting of this application for permission to produce the well as a dual completion with gas from the Yates and oil from the Queen is in the interest of conservation and the protection of correlative rights.

(e) That the granting of this application for permission to dually complete at this time will allow the R. Olsen Oil Company to perform the dual completion work before the drilling rig is moved off the location and will result in a saving of time and expense.

(f) That the applicant will comply with all rules and regulations of New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to maintain separation of production from the two pay zones.

(g) That the manner and method of the proposed dual completion is mechanically feasible and practical.

(h) That by copy of this letter of application, all offset operators are notified of the proposed dual completion.

Therefore, R. Olsen Oil Company requests that the Oil Conservation Commission grant permission to the applicant to dually complete the subject well as proposed in this application.
