Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, The Texas Company wishes to state the following:

- a. That the applicant requested by letter of application dated May 11, 1955, permission to dually complete its J. D. Young Well No. 3. This well will be located 660 feet from south line and 1980 feet from east line of Section 5, T-24S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- b. That the applicant proposes to assign this well a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the entire lease or 160 acres which is the SE/4 of Section 5, T-24S, R-37E, Lea County, New Mexico.
- c. That the entire proposed non-standard proration unit is wholly within the horizontal and vertical limits of the Jalmat Gas Pool as set out in Order R-520.
- d. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section that does not exceed 5280 feet in length or width and that it consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
- e. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas. That the Commission has previously approved non-standard proration units as shown on attached Exhibit "A" for offset wells as follows:


