Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for administrative approval of a non-standard 160-acre gas proration unit comprising the E/2 W/2 Section 6, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This unit will be dedicated to the Carter Eaves (NCT-A) Well No. 1 located 660 feet from the north line and 1980 feet from the west line of this Section 6. The attached plat shows the proposed non-standard unit outlined in red and the unit well is circled and colored in red.

In support of this application, the following facts are submitted:

- Applicant's Carter Eaves (NCT-A) Well No. 1 is now assigned an 80-acre non-standard unit comprising the E/2 NM/4 Section 6, T-24-S, R-37-E, by Administrative Order NSP-466 dated January 5, 1959.
- (2) All Working Interest Owners and Royalty Owners under the E/2 W/2 of Section 6 have agreed to pool their respective interests for Jalmat gas production by Gas Pooling Agreement dated June 14, 1965.
- (3) The proposed non-standard unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lies wholly within a single governmental section.
- (4) The proposed non-standard unit is reasonably presumed to be gas productive in the Jaimat Gas Pool.
- (5) The length or width does not exceed 5,280 feet.
- (6) All operators in the Section in which the proposed non-standard unit is located, and within 1500 feet of the unit well, have been furnished a copy of this application.
