

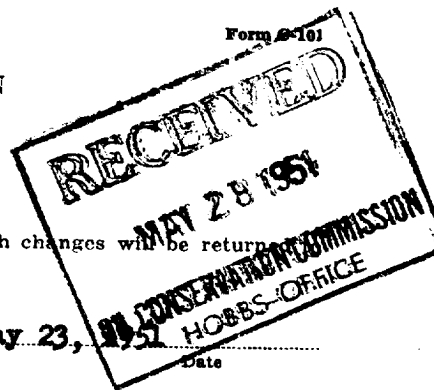

If changes in the above plans become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 3480 feet.

Additional information: A Halliburton DV multiple stage cementing tool will be set in the top of the Rustler Anhydrite at approximate depth of 1200' to facilitate two stage cementing. Approximately 900 sacks of cement will be used in the first stage and approximately 900 sacks will be used in the second stage.
