MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

OXY USA Inc. Myers Langlie Mattix Unit #134 Lea County, New Mexico Lease No. NM-7488

This plan is submitted with the Sundry Notice to Re-Enter the above described well. The purpose of the plan is to identify the location of the well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal may be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation.

The well had been staked by a registered New Mexico land surveyor and the work area was never reclaimed after it was P&A'd in 1992. Mariah Associates, Inc. made an archaeological reconnaissance of the surrounding area and access roads. Their findings concerning cultural resources was reported to the Bureau of Land Management.

1. <u>Existing Roads</u>

A copy of a USGS "Rattlesnake Canyon, New Mexico" quadrangle map is attached showing the location of the well as staked. The well is spotted on this map, which also shows the existing road system and proposed access road. Exhibit "A".

Directions to location:

From Eunice, New Mexico, go south on State Highway 18 to 0.9 miles past mile marker 19. Turn right or west on the Jal #4 Plant road and go 0.6 miles to "T" in road. Turn left at "T" and go 0.2 miles, then turn left and go 0.2 miles. Turn left again and go 0.1 miles to location.

2. Planned Access Road

Existing lease roads will be used to access this location and no new roads will be built.

3. <u>Existing Wells</u>

Existing wells within a one mile radius of the proposed development well are shown on Exhibit "B".
