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- E. Residences and Other Structures: The nearest occupied dwelling in the area is located 2.5 miles to the northwest of the proposed location.
- F. Archaeological, Historical and Cultural Sites: None observed in the area. Mariah Associates, Inc. has completed an archaeological reconnaissance of the work area and report has been submitted to the Bureau of Land Management.
- G. Land Use: Cattle ranching and hunting in season.
- H. Surface Ownership: The wellsite and access road are on Fee surface. The surface is owned by Deep Wells Ranch of Jal, New Mexico 88252, phone 505/395-3149. OXY USA Inc. has meet with Deep Wells Ranch and have reached agreement on surface damages and surface restoration. They will be notified of our intention to re-enter prior to any activity.

Upon completion of the well, all unattended pits containing liquid will be fenced and the liquid portion allowed to evaporate before the pits are broken and backfilled.

All waste associated with the re-entry operation will be gathered in steel bins and disposed of in a proper manner. The well site, if a producer, will be maintained and kept clean of all trash and litter which detracts from the surrounding environment. Equipment will be maintained in accordance with good operating practice.

After the wellsite is cleaned and pits and sumps backfilled, any obstruction to the natural drainage will be corrected by ditching or terracing. All disturbed areas, including any access road no longer needed, will be ripped. Those areas will be reseeded with grass if, in the opinion of the land owner, it is required.
