Dear Mr. Yeckel:

We have today received Form C-110 and Form C-106 on your Toby Lease, Well #2. Under remarks on Form C-110, Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil, you state "Form C-106 filed April 14, 1940."

I have checked my files and find that the first Notice of Intention to Drill the Toby #2 Well was filed by Carl B. King on September 24, 1941, and was approved by Mr. Roy Yarbrough. On January 31, 1942, we received corrected Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, the correction being in the footage of the well. This form also was approved by Mr. Yarbrough. Then, according to our records, this location was abandoned.

On July 11, 1947, we received another Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, a Toby #2 Well by King, Warren & Dye in the same location as was originally submitted by Carl B. King and approved by Mr. Yarbrough on September 24, 1941.

Will you please advise us the reason for this remark so that we can approve this form without further delay.
