This date received an answer to my inquiry as to the status of the above-named well.

The well was incorrectly classified as a Langlie-Mattix gas well on December 14, 1953. According to the operator, the well has a formation packer which has effectively separated the Langlie-Mattix oil pool from the Jalmat gas pool.

Although the operator is presently planning to recomplete the Toby #2 as a gas-oil dual and shut in the gas zone on the Toby #1, it is my recommendation that the Toby #1 be reclassified as a Jalmat gas well and a Langlie-Mattix oil well with the operator submitting appropriate forms.
