DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Pulled 2" EUE Tubing and loaded hole with oil. Shot with 112 quarts of L.N.G. from 3513' to 3569', 2 quarts per foot. After shot reran tubing and found 125' to clean out. Cleaned out hole and reran tubing set at 3579', 7' off bottom. Flowed 67.75 bbls. oil in 24 hours on various chokes ranging from 12/64" to 16/64" choke, Casing Pressure 400#, Tubing Pressure 80#. Last 15 hours, flowing on 16/64" choke, 56.67 bbls. oil, Casing Pressure 400#, Tubing Pressure 80#, Gas Vol. 128M. G.O.R. 2051.
