## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has been drilled to a total depth of 3495'.

5-1/2" Casing has been set at 3475', cemented with 250 sacks El Toro and 50 sacks of Incor Cement. The plug was pumped to 3435', at 6 P.M. 11-14-41.

We propose to let this well stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours after which time we will apply 1000# pump pressure to the pipe and connections, close the valves and observe the pressure for 30 minutes. If there is no drop in pressure, the cement plug will then be drilled and the same test again applied. If there is no drop in pressure, drilling will then be resumed.
