3856' T.D. - 7-5/8" Casing at 317'. 5-1/2" casing @ 3495'. Perforated 5 1/2" casing from 2857 to 2950', 2990' to 3065' and from 3380' to 3460' and acidized with 1500 gallons - After cleaning up, well flowed as follows:
