Well was fractured with 10,000 gallons Dowell oil and 10,000# sand in open hole 3398-3537 feet. Injection rate 19 BPM. Shut in 12 hours. Swabbed 5 hours, well kicked off, flowed estimated 10 BOPH, FCP 360#. Recovered load oil.
