Gentlemen:

Under provisions of Order H-316, Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, Stanolind Oil and Gas Company makes application for administrative approval to dually complete and produce its Cortland Myers "B" Well No. 13, NW/4 of SW/4 of Section 9, Township 24-S, Range 37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. This dual completion will be effected using procedure to allow gas from the Yates-Seven Rivers formation to be produced through the casing-tubing annulus, and oil from the Queen formation through the tubing by selective perforations and installation of suitable packer equipment.
