# DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE

1776

## WE, the Representatives of the United States of America, in General Congress assembled, do hereby declare, that the United States of America, are, and of right ought to be, a free and independent State, and that they are absolved from all allegiance to the British Crown, and that all political connection with them is hereby totally dissolved.

That the United States of America, have, and of right ought to have, full power to levy War, conclude Peace, contract Alliances, enter into Commercials, and to do all other Acts and Things which Independent States may of right do.
