Dear Sir:

Receipt is acknowledged of "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated May 5, 1952 covering your well No. 1 Yeager located on subject land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, section 10, T. 24S, R. 37E, Langlie-Mattix Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which will be furnished upon request, and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. The 8 5/8" casing should be cemented at approximately 300 feet, instead of 200 feet as proposed, and should be cemented with sufficient cement to reach the surface behind the casing.
3. Cement behind the 5 1/2" casing should extend about 200 feet above the top of the Salado salt section, as determined by a temperature survey to be made within 12 hours after completion of the cement job.
