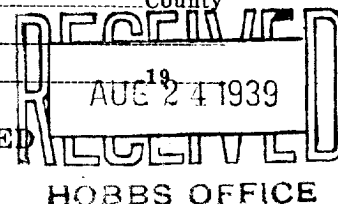

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED



HOBBS OFFICE

On August 10, 1939, well was shot with 180 qts of S.N.G. in 3" shells from 3476' to 3600', shot stemmed with oil and exploded with Zero Hour Bomb

Production before shot: Swabbed 32 bbls oil thru casing in 24 hours, very little gas.

Production after shot: Swabbed 60 bbls oil thru 2" tubing in 24 hours, gas estimated at 50,000 cu. ft.
