Due to excessive Lost Circulation at a depth of 747 feet in our No. 2 B-10 Well, located 560 feet from N.L. & 1900 feet from W.L. in the NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 Section 10-T24S-R37E. We propose to make a water well of this No. 2 Well, and move 100 feet N and 100 feet E of this location to drill our No. 2I (Green 24. Test to a total depth of approximately 3600 feet.

Set 260 feet of 2-5/8" O.D. X 32# casing and cement to surface.

Set 3350 feet of 5-1/2" O.D. X 15.93# casing and cement to surface.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
