DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 28, 1944 we submitted the form C-102, notice of intention to test casing shut-off on the above well. We set the 7" O.D. casing at 3350', cementing with 150 sacks of cement. We allowed same to set 72 hours after which time we drilled the plug and ~~made~~ the test for the water shut-off which we found to be a complete shut-off. Halliburton Cementing Company cemented this casing.
