DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 1:00 A. M. July 21, 1950, 36 hours had elapsed since cementing 2570' of 4" O.D. liner and hanger assembly at 5806' with 200 sacks of cement. Cement circulated behind the liner and 35 sacks of excess cement were circulated out of the casing.

The casing was tested by applying 1000 psi and holding for a period of one hour. No pressure drop occurred during the test period.
