FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Confirming verbal approval of intention to deepen the subject well, details of the proposed deepening operations are submitted as follow:

We propose to deepen the existing hole from present total depth of 3540' to approximately 4975'. At present, the 5-1/2" casing is set at 3318'.

A rotary drilling rig will clean out the old hole and drill a 4-3/4" hole to total depth. A 4" O.D. flush joint liner will be run from approximately 3250' to total depth and cemented with 150% of the theoretical volume of cement required to fill up to 3250' (inside the old casing). (over)
