This report will supersede report filed on Form C-102, 4-20-55.

This well was formerly designated State "AA" Unit Well #1 in the Fowler Field. After drilling to a depth of 10,755 and encountering no commercial production, well was plugged back to 3782' and temporarily abandoned in May 1953, pending further operations.

We propose to perform the following work:

Perforate intervals 3230-3255, 3270-3315, 3350-3415, 3450-3465, and 3474-3484, with 2 shots per foot. Set 9-5/8" packer and holddown on 4" tubing at 3200' and sand oil frac with 20,000 gal lease crude, 20,000 pounds sand and 0.1 pound adomite per gal. If the oil zone is productive, perforate the Jalmat gas zone intervals 2515-2630, 2645-2760, 2770-2790, 2815-2825, 2845-2855, 2870-2885, 2940-2955, 3005-3015, 3050-3070, 3085-3100 with 2 shots per foot, and frac with 20,000 gal lease crude and 20,000 pounds sand. Test and potential well.
