Gentlemen:

We propose to recomplete our State "D" Well No. 3, located 330' FEEL and 2650' FEEL, Section 17, T-24-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico from the Fowler Devonian Oil Pool to the Fowler Blinbry Oil Pool.

The Devonian Zone has been depleted, and the Blinbry Zone appears to have completion possibilities. Various intervals between 5500' and 5594' is to be opened and evaluated. If a producer is obtained it will be necessary that we obtain exceptions to the Fowler Blinbry Oil Pool Rules and Regulations, Order R-2424-A.

In accordance with the above, and in order for our obtaining an allowable immediately, in the event of a successful completion, we ask that you, as offset operator, waive any objection to our securing the necessary approvals, for a non-standard proration unit and an unorthodox well location.

The necessity of the above approvals are due to the recompletion of a previously drilled well at an unorthodox location and the acreage on which the well was drilled encompasses only a single quarter-quarter section.
