TD 7718'. On 8-5-64, 4-1/2" OD 9.5-11.6# J-55 casing was set at 7714' with 600 sx cement. Tested casing with 3500 psi for 30 minutes. Test OK.

Perforated 7692'-7702' W/23SPF and acidized with 1000 gallons. Recovered water. Squeezed with 100 sx cement. Drilled out to 7703'. Reperforated 7692-7702' W/23PF and acidized with 500 gal. Recovered water with slight show of oil. Squeezed with 100 sx cement and drilled out to 7699'. Perforated 7692-98' W/23PF and acidized W/500 gal. Recovered 42 BLN x 258 BHW x 3 BG in 39 hours on sub. Squeezed with 100 sx cement. Drilled out to shoe at 7718 and formation to 7737'. Acidized open hole with 500 gal. No. shows of oil or gas. Set GI Retainer at 7647' & squeezed below with 100 sx cement. Perforated Blinbry zone 5513-24', 5540-60', 5590-99' W/2 3PF. Acidized with 6000 gal. On PT well pumped 22 BG x 69 BW in 24 hours. GR 37'.

Instructions
