Location

The proposed drill location measures 400 x 400 ft and is situated in the: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T24S. R37E, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (BLM).

The existing road will be used as access for this location.

Terrain

Local topography is distinguished by an undulating plain composed of shallow to moderately deep soils. Soils are loamy, are mixed with caliche gravel, and are underlain by caliche duripan.

Floristics

The local floral community is represented by the following species:

Prosopis juliflora, Gutierrezia sarothrae, Agropyron smithii, Bouteloua eriopoda, and Eragrostis intermedia. Gutierrezia sarothrae is the most commonly occurring species.

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
