INTRODUCTION

An archaeological reconnaissance was recently completed by the Agency for Conservation Archaeology (ACA), Eastern New Mexico University, Portales, for Amoco Production Company in Lea County, New Mexico. The reconnoitered area will be impacted by the construction of a natural gas drilling location. This project was completed under Federal Antiquities Permit No. 78-NM-O15 and was administered by Mr. Bob Couch, representative for Amoco, and Dr. J. Loring Haskell, Director - Principal Investigator, ACA. The reconnaissance was conducted by Thomas F. Zale on 12 May 1978.

SURVEY TECHNIQUE

The archaeologist accomplished the reconnaissance by walking a series of parallel transects, spaced at a distance of 20 ft apart, over the proposed drilling location. This technique served to maximize the visual investigation of areas of primary and secondary impact arising from the proposed construction.
