Sun Oil Company's application to drill the No. 1 Teas Federal Com. was approved by your letter dated July 14, 1978. This permit was issued to Sun Oil Company, P.O. Box 1861, Midland, Texas 79702 originally. Effective June 1, 1978, Sun Oil Company, Oklahoma City District, 2525 Northwest Expressway, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112, assumed operation of various gas properties in New Mexico and the No. 1 Teas Federal Com. was one of them.

Due to the lack of availability of a suitable drilling rig and inclement weather conditions, we were unable to drill this well.

On October 2, 1978, we were granted a ninety (90) day extension by your office, with this extension expiring January 14, 1979.

Respectfully request another ninety (90) day extension be granted Sun Oil Company in order for us to secure a suitable drilling rig.
