Sun Oil Company's application to drill the No. 1 Teas Federal Com. was approved by your letter dated July 14, 1978. This permit was issued to Sun Oil Company, P.O. Box 1861, Midland, Texas 79702 originally. Effective June 1, 1978 Sun Oil Company, Oklahoma City District, 2525 Northwest Expressway, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73112 assumed operation of various gas properties in New Mexico and the No. 1 Teas Federal Com was one of them.

Due to the lack of availability of a suitable drilling rig, we would like to delay the drilling of the subject well at this time.

It is our understanding this permit was granted for ninety (90) days and will expire October 11, 1978. We respectfully request that Sun Oil Company be granted a ninety (90) day extension in order to have time to secure a suitable drilling rig.
