Gentlemen:

Attached is our C-103 covering workover of Exxon's S.W. Harrison, Well #9, Unit "K", Sec. 25, T24S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Custer Devonian (Gas) Pool.

Prior to workover $5\frac{1}{2}$ casing was perf 10311-315, 10322-330, and 10390-10416'. Perforations from 10390-10416 were squeezed off and reperforated from 10311-315, 10322-330 with 2 SPF (28 shots). Acidized perforations 10311-315, 10322-330 with 1500 gals. 15% NE HC1.

On potential well pumped 100 BO, 229 MCF gas, plus 117 bbls. water, gravity 40.4 at 60 degrees.

Based on the results of the above workover Exxon requests this well be classified as an oil well in the Custer Devonian Gas Pool.
