

### Location

This location will measure 450 X 450 ft on federal lands and will be situated 330 ft from the south line and 420 ft from the west line of:

Section 9, T24S, R37E, NMPM, Lea County, NM

Thus it will be situated in the:

SW1SW1, Section 9, T24S, R37E, NMPM, Lea County, NM

Its accompanying access road will measure 12 X 150 ft and will be situated in the:

SW1SW1, Section 9, T24S, R37E, NMPM, Lea County, NM

SE1SW1, Section 9, T24S, R37E, NMPM, Lea County, NM

### Terrain

This location is situated within the bounds of a shallow uvala. This surface, as well as its immediate surroundings, is overlain by a thick deposit of sandy clay loams and loamy sands lacking lithic caliche inclusions. Drainage is toward the west and hence into the uvala. As a whole, this portion of the Eunice Plain is marked by interior drainage. Soils belong to the Typic Torripsamment subgroup.

### Floristics

In general, this landform supports a mixed overstory of Artemisia filifolia and Quercus havardii and lesser amounts of Prosopis juliflora and Yucca glauca. Of these latter plants, Yucca is decidedly rare. Encountered forbs, in terms of relative abundance, include Lepidium sp., Solanum elaeagnifolium,
