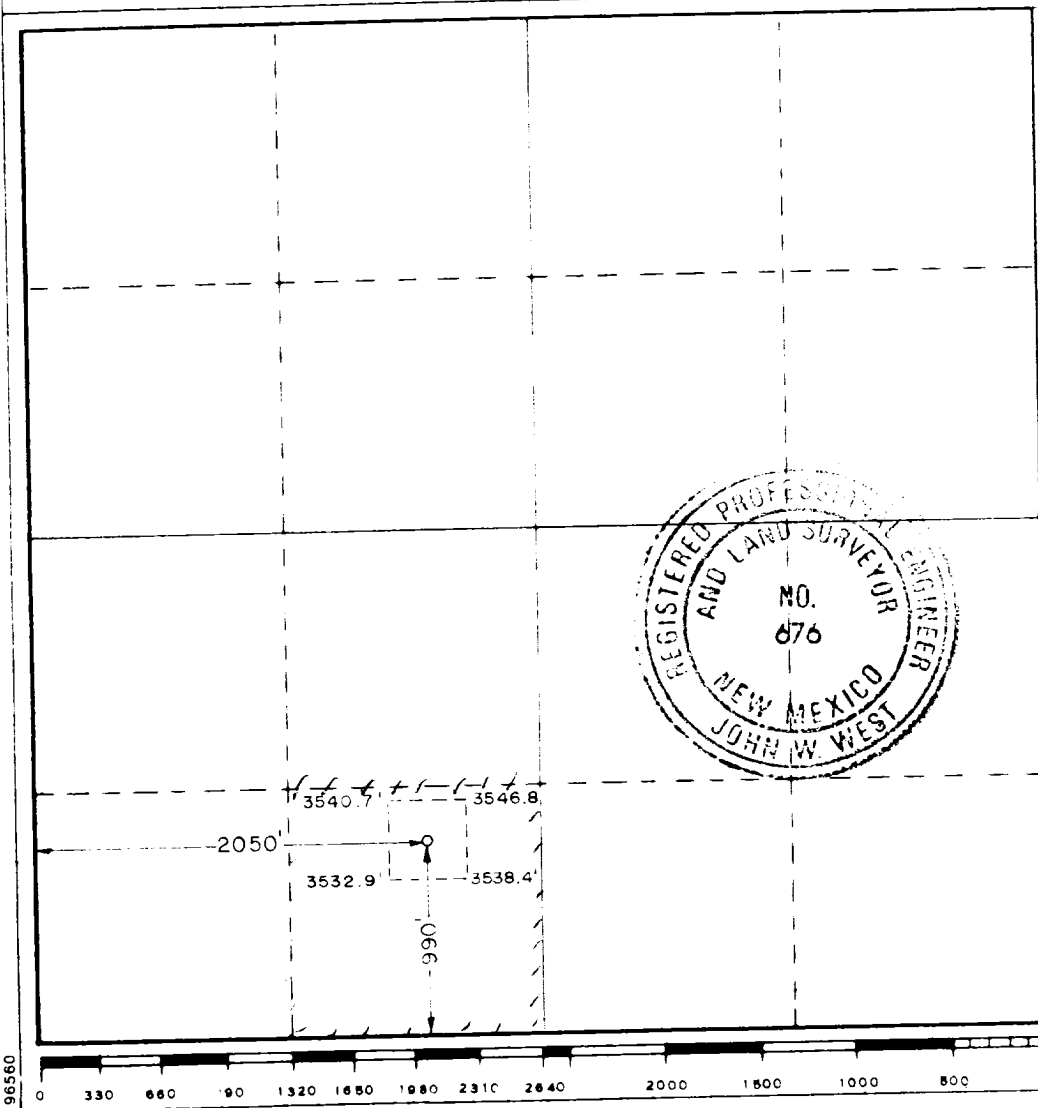

Subject: Addendum to PAC Report No. 88109, Grover McKinney Federal Well No. 5 and Attendant Access Road.

On July 18, 1988, Pecos Archeological Consultants submitted an archeological clearance report for a well pad scheduled for construction by the Grover McKinney Oil Company.

this well was originally to be located 990 ft from the south line and 1800 ft from the west line of section 9, T20S, R33E, N4PM, Lea County, N.M. No archeological remains were encountered during the survey of this well pad.

On August 22, 1988, Pecos Archeological Consultants was contacted to provide an additional survey as the well was to be moved 250 ft east. The new staking will be located 990 ft from the south line and 2050 ft from the west line, in section 9, T20S, R33E, N4PM, Lea County, N.M. This survey was performed on August 23, 1988, by James E. Hunt. It consisted of a 200 X 400 ft area (1.83 acres) adjacent to the original survey area. No cultural remains were encountered in the new impact zone.
