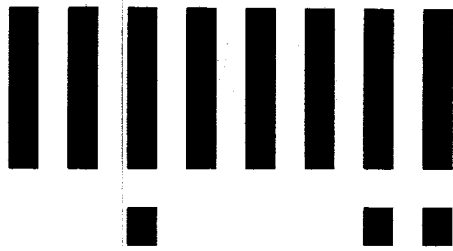
RE: REQUEST AND NOTICE FOR:  
SIMULTANEOUS DEDICATION  
COURTLAND MYERS LEASE  
SW/4 SECTION 5  
T24S, R37E  
LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Gentlemen:

We are currently in the process of filing a C-101 and C-102 with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's district office in Hobbs for permission to drill a second Jalmat (Gas) well as an infield well to the same producing interval on an existing 160-acre proration unit comprised of the SW/4 Section 5, T24S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. The subject proration unit is currently dedicated to our Courtland Myers #2 located in Section 5, T24S, R37E, Unit P. I hereby file for administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate the 160-acre proration unit, consisting of the SW/4 of Section 5 to both our existing well (Courtland Myers #2) located in Sec. 5, 24S 37E, Unit ~~m~~ ~~P~~ and our newly proposed well (Courtland Myers #10) located in Sec. 5, R24S, R37E, Unit K).

Three copies of a plat showing the location of the original well on the existing 160-acre proration unit plus the location of the proposed well are enclosed.

Copies of this plat and application have also been sent to all offsetting parties owning shallow Jalmat dry gas rights. The following is a list of the offset Jalmat owners:

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
