### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth 1183' anhydrite. Ran 39 jts. of 8-5/8" 24# casing, 1169.33' and set at 1179.88' and cemented with 625 sax. Plug down 6:15 AM 5-13-50. Cement was allowed to set 24 hours, plug drilled out, 1000# pressure applied with all valves closed, no drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed.
