Well was spudded at 11 A.M. 3-26-55. Completed 17½" hole at 5:30 A.M. 3-27-55. Ran 11 joint of 13-3/8" 48# H-40 casing. Total 332.42' set at 345.67'. B-J cemented with 200 sacks of Lone Star cement with 3% gel and 100 sacks of Lone Star Regular neat. Plug down at 11:22 A.M. 3-27-55. Cement circulated. WOC 24 hours. Started drilling cement plug at 11:30 A.M. 3-28-55. Drilled to 350'. Tested formation with 500#. Pressure held. Resumed drilling.
